MAGNOLIA RIDGE POOL RULES

- Current Year Magnolia Ridge Pool Passes are required at all times for admittance (please sign-in and show your pass to the gate guard or lifeguard)
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a person age 16 or older
- Proper swimming attire required (no cut-off jeans, shorts or underwear)
- Rubber/Swimmy Diapers required for all children who are not potty trained
- No Running/Horseplay
- No Diving or Flips
- No Smoking within Pool Gates
- No Alcoholic Beverages
- No Glass Containers
- No Pets
- No Foul Language
- Children with floaters are not allowed beyond roped area unless accompanied by an adult
- The wading pool is for young children and their supervising adult only
- Lifeguard has the authority to deny use of floaters when deemed appropriate

Lifeguards and Management Staff have full authority to enforce the Pool Rules and remove violators from the pool area. In addition, the rules are subject to change at the discretion of Management and/or the Lifeguards to ensure the safety of all guests.

Guest policy and Fees:

Guests/visitors must be accompanied by a homeowner at all times and are the responsibility of the homeowner. Two guests are permitted free per household/address with the Visitor passes; a \$5 fee will be due for each additional guest *per day*.

Rain Days:

Swim Metro will keep the pool open with reduced staff on rain days until two hours before the scheduled closing time. If the weather is still unsuitable for swimming, the pool will be closed for the day. At the first sighting of lightning or sound of thunder, the pool deck will be cleared for 30 minutes. The 30-minute period will start over upon each additional sighting of lightning or sound of thunder. The pool and pool area will reopen when 30 minutes have passed without any sighting of lightning or sound of thunder. In the absence of thunder and lightning, the pool may also be temporarily closed if rainfall becomes so intense that the bottom of the pool is not visible and will reopen when visibility clears.

Parties:

A group with over ten guests is a party. All parties must be scheduled with Swim Metro and by emailing <u>pool@magnoliaridge.org</u>. All appropriate fees must be paid. See the head lifeguard for information and pool rental policy posted at <u>www.magnoliaridge.org</u>.
